Whether you are chosen to serve on the STL team is not the only point. Dig deep inside, answer the questions, and complete the service project with the intent of learning something new.

Applications must be completed and all elements turned in by Tuesday, April 25th, 3:00 PM. Be prompt and professional with your application. A submitted application does not guarantee an interview. An interview schedule will be available after the staff has had time to review submitted applications.

Please make sure that all elements are enclosed in one package and are clearly labeled with your name. Any elements of your application that you would like returned need to be clearly labeled as such. All applications must be typed or clearly legible. Failure to do so will result in the return of the application to the applicant.
