#### **Regular Morning & Evening Rehearsal at Jenks**

M111 and M110 cleared out after evening rehearsal in preparation for luggage check in.

#### Friday, October 11th

7:30 AM Roll Call, Medicine Check In, and Luggage Check In Be aware that Providence Working Canines will be present and conducting safety sweeps of all luggage, equipment trucks, and buses. Providence is often called upon to conduct a safety sweep of student's belongings prior to taking an overnight trip. This extra measure of Student Safety provides both Administration and Chaperones peace of mind.

**ALL** luggage must be marked with proper identification, including name & desired contact information.

Medicine Check in will be small orchestra room.

You are allowed one normal-sized suitcase (which is loaded underneath the bus) and one carry-on bag for the bus. Your suitcase should include your show shirt, and the clothes/items you will need for Saturday & Sunday. <u>All</u> students will be required to wear their show shirt on Saturday afternoon. Students should check the forecast for the Dallas area in order to be prepared for the weather.

Upon arrival, be ready for instructions from chaperones. Luggage and uniforms will be organized by buses to ease the loading process later that day. Luggage check-in for buses 3-6 will be in M111 and luggage check-in for buses 1-2 will be in M 110. Medicine check-in is in the small orchestra room (M102).

Campus police recommends that you have someone bring you to the band room. If you have to leave your vehicle here, do not leave anything of value in your vehicle and give further cause for break in or theft.

#### 8:15 AM Bus Unload in Lot

All students exit the bus with all performance items. We are restricted to the time scheduled. Delays in load/unloading times may result loss of warm-up time and/or penalties - we must be ready to move at the appropriate time. Students that need to get instruments & equipment from equipment trucks go immediately to where they are parked.

All students take water jugs with you to warm up. We will use them, place them outside the gate before entering, and get them when exiting the gate.

#### 9:10-9:40 AM Pit Warm Up – Area C

Be ready to concentrate in an outside environment, right next to other groups warming up as well. Weather and noise will be a factor.

#### 9:10-9:55 AM Warm Up – Area C

(Includes brass, woodwinds, guard, and battery) We will utilize some type of compact fundamental block. Be ready to concentrate in what will be a smaller, cramped area that is right next to another band doing the same thing. Tubas and Battery may be allowed to dismount during this warm up time if space allows.

The warm up for this contest is an all-inclusive warm up for 45 minutes. As usual, we will separate in the 3 segments: stretch and body, sectionals, and full group warm-ups. We will be surrounded by other bands going through the same process. It will be loud. Concentrate on what we are doing. Do no be distracted as we prepare for competition.

#### 10:15 AM Performance

Remember - there are two sets of hash marks – HS and College (just like home). The inside (Texas hs/college) hashmarks are part of the field (white paint) and the outside (OK high school) hashmarks will be taped (yellow tape) on the field. The inserts will be on the inside (TX) hashes for this field – be aware of this change.

No outside video or audio equipment is allowed in the stadium. BOA has contracted to have all championships professionally recorded. Still camera photography may be used from stadium seating but not on the field - even by personnel with field passes. Tripods and other similar equipment are not allowed as they may obstruct the view or path of others.

10:30 AM	<b>Post Performance</b> No group photo. Stay in uniform. Instruments & props placed back on equipment trucks. Equipment Trucks stay on site all day.
11:15 AM	<b>Depart for hotel</b> Stay in uniform, buses head back to hotel, keep equipment and trucks there.
12:15 PM	Arrive at hotel

Lunch at hotel. Change out of show performance costume. Costume should be properly hung in hanging bag and in the closet of hotel room. Keep showhair. Downtime for everyone. If you shower, you will have to redo showhair before departure.

2:30 PM Load Buses Bring uniforms – hang in cabin of buses. Bring items to touch up show hair. Students wearing showshirt – this is required. Bring maroons & grays for finals to wear with show performance costume.

# Medicine Information for BOA – \*Important Medicine Info\*

ALL medicine must be turned in before luggage check-in

# (7:30 AM Friday, Oct 11th)

*in the* **ORIGINAL** *prescription bottle with the correct instructions on the bottle.* 

The medicines must be in the original bottle in a zip lock plastic bag with your student's name written on the bag with a sharpie.

# Medicine not in its original bottle will not be accepted.

## Medicine will be distributed from your child's medicine bottle. This is a law and nonnegotiable! This is also the same policy as the school.

This includes any over-the-counter medicines. The band has Tylenol and Ibuprofen available, but if your student needs cough medicine or antihistamines or other such over the counter medicines on a regular basis, please supply this. Over-the-counter medicines need to be in a new and sealed package. Placed in a ziplock bag with your child's name on it and instructions written out. Please also include any special instructions - such as specific times the student receives the medicine or if it is taken with food.

We take the safety of your children seriously and ask for your cooperation! If there is a problem with medicine check in, you will be notified while the students are rehearsing and we will help you find a solution.

*If you have your medicine information on file with the school nurse, you can contact them to get a copy of it. You are responsible for getting the form from the nurse to us on Thursday morning.* 

If your child uses an inhaler – we need this information presented as well – documentation and usage instructions. They can keep the inhaler with them, but we need you to come to medicine drop off to sign the forms.

Also, if your child uses an inhaler – THEY MUST BRING IT. Sharing of inhalers is NOT something we want to do. Please be sure the inhaler has an ample supply of medication and will last through Sunday.
