

OSSAA District 13 Solo and Ensemble Contest

Included are two maps of the middle school. They show you where to park and the location of all the rooms that are being used for the contest. Rooms are listed by the family of instruments and the actual classroom number (e.g.- String 1603).

We will have a tuned, upright console piano in each room. If your student's are using recorded accompaniment you must provide your own stereo or electronic equipment.

The percussion room will have the following equipment: Marimba (Yamaha 4.5 Synthetic) Marimba (Yamaha 4.3 Synthetic) Xylophone (Yamaha 4.5 Octave Synthetic) Vibraphone (Yamaha 3 Octave Goldbar without Motor) Orchestra Bells (Standard Yamaha)

Chimes (Standard Musser Edition) 4 Timpani (Yamaha 32", 29", 26", 23") Bass Drum (Yamaha Concert Bass) Gong (Wu Han 26")

No food or drink is allowed in the hallways or classrooms where the events will be held. If you are here during lunchtime, there are several places to eat on Riverside Drive, which is just West of the Middle School.

No playing in the hallways. All activities are on the 1st floor. Do not allow students to venture in unused areas on the 1st, 2nd or 3rd floors. Please remind your students of this before and during the event.

Remember that all performers must have the original, copyrighted music with numbered measures for the judge. According to OSSAA regulations, a student will not be allowed to perform without it. Ratings will be periodically posted throughout the day in the cafeteria. Complete results will be posted on the OSSAA website soon after.

The contest office will be in the faculty lunchroom, which is in the Northwest corner of the cafeteria. You can come to pick up your packets at the completion of your schools' events. There will not be a sign out sheet so make sure that you have the correct number of certificates and medals in your packet before you leave. Please assign an adult to pick up this packet if you are not able to do so yourself. No students are allowed in the contest office.
