

Branson Trip Information

As you probably know by now, the 8th grade band will be taking a one-day trip to Branson at the end of this school year. The students will be participating in the Heartland Music Festival in Hollister, MO as well as spending the rest of the day at Silver Dollar City in Branson.

What is the Heartland Music Festival?

The Heartland Music Festival is a music contest with junior high or high school bands, orchestras, or choirs competing from several states. The contest will take place at a venue near Silver Dollar City.

When is the trip?

The trip will take place on Saturday, May 2nd. Students will be at the middle school band room by 5:10 AM and be home at 10:30 PM. More time specifics are listed in the Branson Trip Itinerary.

Who will attend?

Because we are performing in a contest, all eighth-grade band students are expected to attend. We will also be looking for parent chaperones for the trip. If you are interested in attending, please indicate on the form at the end of this letter.

What is the cost?

The cost of the trip per student is \$125 and the cost for chaperones will be \$100 if you do not have a season pass. This will cover the cost of charter buses, festival fees, park entrance, lunch in the park, and dinner on the bus. If you do have a season pass, the cost for students is \$60 and for chaperones is \$25. The cost of the entire trip is due no later than Wednesday, April 22nd.

Payments may be made online through InTouch online (through the parent's PowerSchool account), through a check made out to Jenks Band, or through cash in an envelope. InTouch payments are preferred.

As a final push to help students obtain the full amount of funds, I have also provided a "Jenks 8th Grade Band Financial Sponsor" form. Students can simply ask family, friends, and relatives if they would like to help sponsor them for the Heartland Music Festival trip by making a donation to the Jenks Band program. Money should be collected at the time of sponsorship, and students may use those funds as payment for

their trip. This sponsor form does not need to be turned in. You may just use the funds collected towards your trip. Checks are payable to Jenks Band.

Are student trip monies refundable?

No. According to the Trip Fund Policy, *“all funds disbursed from the trip fund shall be considered non-refundable unless the Director of Instrumental Music cancels the trip and a refund is available and received from the provider of the contracted service.”* All students are expected to attend the trip. Dropped enrollment, academic ineligibility, or disciplinary restrictions as determined by the middle school administration are not valid reasons for non-payment or refund of payment for trip expenses. According to the Jenks Student Handbook, students who do not meet their financial obligations will have their name placed “on hold” as outlined in the Handbook.

How do parents become chaperones?

We would love for you to chaperone this trip! Please simply fill out the form at the bottom of this letter to indicate that you are interested in chaperoning. I will need to know the names of chaperones by Wednesday, April 22nd. Because of limited space on the buses, we may need some chaperones to drive themselves. (However, driving chaperones will have a very limited role.) In addition, I will be looking for one chaperone who would be willing to pick up Chick-Fil-A sandwiches for us a few miles from the park. Please let me know on the form what your preference is regarding riding or driving.
