## RULES OF CONDUCT FOR OVERNIGHT BAND TRIPS

- 1. Do not go anywhere by yourself.
- 2. No illegal drugs, alcoholic beverages, or tobacco.
- 3. No shoplifting.
- 4. Students are only allowed in their assigned room. Students may not go into another student's room.
- 5. Do not leave your room after curfew/room check.
- 6. You are personally responsible for any damages sustained in your room during your stay. If you enter your room at check in and notice anything wrong, notify the chaperone <u>immediately</u>.
- 7. Be courteous to each other, and respectful and obedient to sponsors.
- 8. You are representing Jenks Public Schools, the City of Jenks, and the state of Oklahoma. Good manners in all facets of behavior leave lasting, positive impressions. Saying "please" and "thank you", avoiding profanity, opening doors, etc. also leave good impressions.
- 9. Public or Private Display of Affection is prohibited. Students are not allowed on other students laps in any form. Blankets on buses are allowed but hands must be on the outside.
- 10. Be prompt with times placed on the schedule. Tardiness will cause a loss of privilege.
- 11. No running or loud noises in the hotel hallways.
- 12. Each person is allowed one suitcase. The suitcase must be a normal size. Pack wisely. The marching uniform should be kept in Jenks hanging and travels bags. You are also allowed one carry-on bag for the bus.
- 13. Only headphones with walkmans, iPods, or DVD players may be used on the bus. No external speakers may be used.
- 14. No switching buses.
- 15. All students are to dress in a manner that complies with school dress code. Do not wear anything provocative or immodest.
- 16. Any movies watched must be rated PG 13 or lower. Movies with questionable contest, excessive violence, language, or skin will not be allowed. Any movies shown on the bus are subject to approval by directors and chaperones.
- 17. Keep track of personal belongings to prevent loss or theft of personal items.
- 18. Students should not act in reckless manner or put anyone (including themselves) in a position where safety is at risk.
- 19. Students should be careful about all social media posts made before, during, and after a trip.
- 20. Students are on a school sponsored activity. All guidelines from the band handbook, Jenks student handbook, and school board policies apply.

Consequences for infraction of rules will range from loss of privilege to being sent home at parent's expense.

Consequences are at the discretion of directors, and Jenks Public Schools, and will be a direct result of the severity of the infraction.
